The program aids children in the system at a certain poverty level and on free lunch. The program provides food for the qualifying children every Friday to take home for the weekend. All schools have some of these needs and some schools more than others. Yates Elementary, in our neighborhood is on total free lunch. Our *Women of Faith Circle* donated \$300.00 to their program last month. Because Yates is 100% they qualify for God's Pantry and funds from the government. Schools that don't qualify, because they have a lower percentage of students receiving free lunches, still have needs. They rely on churches, individuals, and their teachers to help out each week. We would like to continue giving to this program as we are able.
